Some FSPs offer reduced fees for older or larger sibling sets, children close to aging out, children on the waiting child list, children with critical medical needs, or other circumstances that make them more difficult to place. A detailed fee schedule specific to the FSP the family chooses will be provided as part of the adoption service agreement. Fees are listed in the currency they are paid in. All fees paid in foreign currency are subject to the exchange rate for the date that they are paid. Fees paid to FSPs are non-refundable.
